It is our privilege to welcome our new families to Borman and to welcome back our current families. It is a true honor for us to serve our military families! The Borman K-8 School mission is to work to provide the very best academic and social opportunities possible for our students.

Our start times will continue to be the same as last year. The times will stay the same for online learning. The first bell will be at 8:20 a.m. and the tardy bell will be at 8:25 a.m. The expectation is that students are in their classrooms or in the online session with their classroom teacher at 8:25 am so instruction may begin.
