## Warm Weather - Sandals

With warmer weather, students like to wear sandals to school. It is very important (and part of our dress code) that **students wear shoes that cover their toes**. With the amount of running and playing that the students encounter; they need proper footwear for the playground. **(Please, no flip flops.)**

## AASA - State Testing

AASA testing will take place during the weeks of **April 4-29** for students in grades **3-8**. (Your student's teacher will provide exact dates.)

- Please help us by making sure that your children are **in school and on time**.
- It is important that our Borman Astros have a good night's **rest** and **eat a good breakfast**.
- **Please make doctor or dentist appointments after dismissal.**
- **Students who begin a section of a test may not finish that section if they leave school.** If you know of an appointment your child has during school hours, **please notify the teacher ahead of time** so that your child does not begin the test on that day. This is very important so that your child has every opportunity to complete the required AzM2 assessment.
- Our goal is to test 100% of our students.

## Borman - Important Reminders

**\*Please do not park in the parent pick-up/drop off area.** This half circle is reserved for families that are ready to drop off or pick up their student/s. This is a **"No Parking" zone**.

**\*We have designated the front parking lot as "no parking-staff parking"** for the safety of our students. We have had four students narrowly missed by cars in that parking lot.

For the safety of our children, please do not park in the parking lot in front of the school. Thank you for helping us keep our Borman Astros safe.

**\*All students must leave the Borman campus at dismissal** unless they are participating in extracurricular activities or are attending tutoring.
