Camp Corral @ Triangle Y Ranch Camp

Camp Corral is free of charge to military families; however, we do require a \$30.00, 100% refundable check deposit (made out to Camp Corral) for each child that is accepted. PLEASE NOTE: deposits submitted via credit card are not refundable for any

reason. Camp Corral is free for children that are accepted and attend a session. The deposit is only required to hold your child's spot.

Triangle Y Ranch Camp is fortunate to work with additional funders and donors that support our military families. Each of these programs varies a little in the criteria for acceptance or the amount of the copay. Some are restricted by rank/pay grade, some by service status, some by Unit, some by deployment date or PCS orders. Since we do not always know from year to year what restrictions might be placed on the funds, we have created a single form that will guide our staff through the process of determining a program. When we get the form, our office staff will match you up with the best funder or donor and will contact you by email with the specifics and help finish the registration.
