It is with a heavy heart that I let you know that we have had some students exhibit aggressive behaviors on the playground and while walking home after school. Please remind your students that if they are upset or angry, that they must use their words to let the other student/s know how they feel. If they have been harmed in any way, they must report it to the teacher, a monitor, Mr. Curran, Mrs. Bonner, Ms. Sisler, or a trusted adult. We cannot stop aggressive behaviors unless we know about them. (Please contact the School Age Program or Youth Center if you are concerned about an incident that occurred there.)

Also important for our students to understand, is that the TUSD/Borman Code of Conduct applies during regular school hours (including when students are going to and from school, “portal to portal,”) The Code of Conduct is also in place while students are on TUSD property, and if on/off campus actions result in a harmful effect on students or the educational process.
