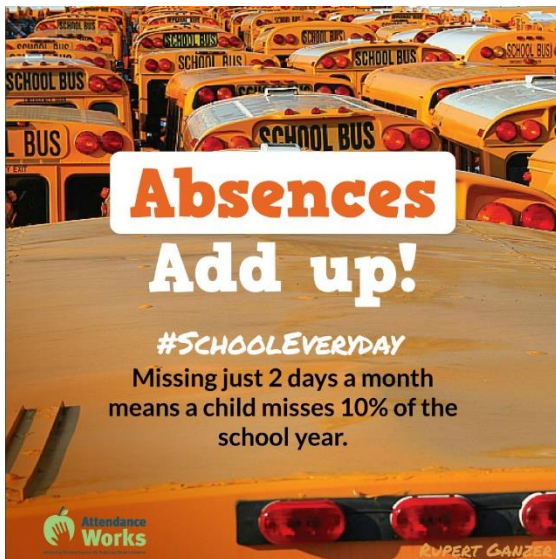
BORMAN SCHOOL COMMUNITY LIAISON

CLASS INTERRUPTIONS

It is common for us to receive up to 10 calls at the end of the day asking us to give messages to students. Before school each morning, please have a discussion with your child about where he/she needs to go at dismissal. We always understand emergencies but would appreciate it if regular daily plans are determined before the school day.

OFFICE REQUEST – We would appreciate it very much if you would make doctor or dentist appointments after school, if possible. Any interruption to our classrooms makes an impact on all students and their learning opportunities. Thank you!

PROCEDURES FOR PARENT-STUDENT DROP OFF AND PICK UP

The loop in front of the school is designated as the Pick-up/Drop-off area. **There is no parking in the loop during morning drop-off or afternoon pick-up at dismissal.**

You may park in the dirt across the street from the school, but we ask that you use the crosswalk to always cross Lightning. We would like our students to use the crosswalk, and parent modeling will help support safe student choices. **Thanks so much for your help!**

STUDENT ARRIVAL

Our **Borman campus does not open until 7:45 AM**, as we do not have staff on site at that time to supervise students. **Please do not drop your students off before 7:45 AM.** Please also ensure that your students **do not walk or ride their bikes to campus before 7:45 AM.** **If students arrive on campus before 7:45 AM, they will be unsupervised, which causes great concern for their safety.** Thank you for your support.
