Important Borman Update! Great News!

Borman K—8 School has been selected to receive the DoDEA PMSI Construction Grant. This grant will provide us with enough funding to build a new Gym/ Multipurpose Room, a Music Suite, a new Food Service area, 7 additional classrooms, an Art room, and a Computer Lab. The existing building will also be renovated and will provide updated classrooms, bathrooms, and more outdoor learning spaces. We will also have a new HVAC system! Tucson Unified School District has designated \$5.2 million and DoDEA will provide another \$21 million for the construction. Our TUSD Project Manager projects that construction will begin in June 2022. More information to come!
